For the purposes of this program, an artist is considered professional if they:

- a) Are recognized as professional by other practitioners working in similar artistic practice.
- b) Are committed to working full-time at their practice when financially possible.
- c) Have completed appropriate and relevant training in their field of practice. Training may be through post-secondary institutions, apprenticeship or traditional knowledge transfer with a qualified practitioner or Knowledge Keeper.
- d) Have a minimum two years of professional practice in their field following basic training.
- e) Have a demonstrated body of previous practice in their field for which they have received professional fees.
